## **The Wawayanda Six**

On December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2015, six protestors\* blocked trucks delivering cement to the construction site of a fracked-gas fueled power plant being built in Wawayanda, NY. Charged with obstructing traffic, they will plead “not guilty by reason of necessity” – the necessity to protect our earth from the devastation of climate change, and our citizens from the health risks of exposure to the toxins emitted by these plants.

**Eminent climate scientists and physicians will provide expert testimony on the health risks of fracked gas combustion and the contributions of fossil fuel emissions to climate change.**

Come learn from these expert witnesses, hear the testimony of the defendants, and show your support for the defendants’ use of non-violent civil disobedience to protect our planet.
